Decisions by the Conference of States Parties

1. At its eighteenth session held on 12 June 2025, the Conference of States Parties to the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities adopted the following decisions:

Decision 1: Venue and timing of the nineteenth session of the Conference of States Parties to the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities

2. The Conference of States Parties to the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, recalling General Assembly resolution 61/106, and taking into consideration rule 1, paragraphs 1 and 2 of the rules of procedure of the Conference, decides that its nineteenth session will be held at United Nations Headquarters in New York from 9 to 11 June 2026.

Decision 2: Resources and support for the Conference of States Parties to the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities

3. The Conference of States Parties to the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities notes the provision of resources and support for the eighteenth session of the conference and reiterates its recommendation to the Secretary-General to continue provide adequate support to the nineteenth and future sessions of the Conference.

Decision 3: Request to the Secretary-General to transmit the report of the eighteenth session of the Conference of States Parties to the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities

4. The Conference of States Parties to the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities decides to request the Secretary-General to transmit the report of the Conference on its eighteenth session to all States Parties and observers.
