Excellency,

We wish to thank delegations for their participation in the informal meeting on Monday, July 15, 2024.

Following consultations, we are attaching an updated version of the proposed draft resolution, which incorporates elements from the feedback received through the various consultations, written submissions and bilateral discussion.

Additionally, we would like to inform you of updates we are proposing to the consultations set to take place on Monday, July 22, in light of the meeting held on Monday, July 15, 2024:

- **From 3:00 to 4:15 pm EST, Trusteeship Council Chamber:** informal consultation with representatives of Indigenous Peoples;
- **From 4:30 to 6:00 pm EST, Trusteeship Council Chamber:** consultation on the draft resolution with representatives of Member States.

It remains our view that a successful outcome can only be achieved by listening to Indigenous Peoples and Member States. It is important that the process remains inclusive and continues to take into consideration the views of Indigenous Peoples representatives and institutions, as mandated in resolution A/71/321, while allowing for a candid exchange among Member States in negotiations.


