




#### Urbanization & Migration Trend

- As **young adults migrate**, the population left behind in rural areas tends to age, creating an uneven demographic balance.
- **Migrant Children** Better opportunities but need to adapt to new environment & culture
- "Left-Behind" Children Emotional & psychological challenges
- Older Migrants Adaption to unfamiliar living arrangements, culture and social isolation
- "Left-Behind" Grandparents In many cases, become the primary caregivers for children after parents migrate -> Additional burdens
- Rise in **Marriage Migrants** -> Leading to new forms of families and new social inequalities


% Population in Urban Area in Selected Regions 1950-projected 2050 (UN, 2014)

#### Challenges

- The social relationship network undergoes fracture and reorganization
- Traditional elderly care models are weakened
- The willingness to bear children continues to decline, while various costs associated with raising children are on the rise
- Rural depopulation




#### Policies


- Strengthen formal social network support and explore the functions of informal networks.
- Support the foundational role of family-based elderly care and improve the social elderly care service system
- Enhance the policy system for fertility support and develop an inclusive childcare service network
- Strengthen resource endowment in rural areas and optimize the development environment for rural families

#### Demographic Shifts

- Since the 1960s, Asia's Total Fertility Rate has steadily decreased
- Now falling below 2 children per woman lower than the replacement level.
- This persistent decline signals a long-term decrease in population, which contrasts sharply with the significant rise in life expectancy—from the mid-40s to around 80 years.



# Asian Family Summit



- In 1990, only 7 Asian countries were considered ageing, with over 7% of their population aged 65 or above.
- By 2024, 31 Asian countries are ageing, including 2 that are super-aged, with over 21% aged 65 or above.
- By 2050, 19 Asian countries are projected to become super-aged.

- Statutory maternity leave extended from 10 to 14 weeks
- Free Quality Kindergarten Education Scheme

- . Paternity leave increased from 3 to 5 days
- . Neighbourhood Support Child Care Project
- . Expansion of affordable childcare e.g. more subsidized childcare centre places and extended-hours day-care





### Climate Change and Families



- Asia is a diverse continent where there are area with rapid urbanization as well as heavy reliance on agriculture
- Families can face very direct impacts from climate change
  - Typically, extreme weather

 84% of youth in Philippines being Extremely or Very Worried about the climate change





- Human Security as one of the key objectives in Philippines National Climate Change Action Plan
- Defined as "to reduce risks of men and women and other vulnerable groups (children, elderly and persons with disability, etc.) from climate and disasters."

#### Specific Policies include:

- Increase local and community capacities for climate change risk management
- Implement community-based public health surveillance system for climate change-sensitive diseases.
- Improve system for health emergency preparedness and response for climate and disaster risks.
- Extensive community education program on climate change risks and population management
- Improve system for health emergency preparedness and response for climate and disaster risks.



# Technological Advancement









#### LifeSG App -

#### **One-Stop Digital Platforms for Families**

 LifeSG offers >40 integrated services for various life stages (covering family and parenting, housing, education, etc.), personalized to each user



- E.g. Simplify the birth registration process from 60 mins to 15 mins
  - 7 out of 10 birth registration using digital platform

#### Virtual Assistant Chatbots

• Answering common questions about family schemes or childcare resources, providing quick answers 24/7.

# Asian Family Summit

#### Social Service Net (SSNet)

- A common database of client information and social program usage
- Enabling different family service providers to coordinate help without making families repeat their concerns multiple times
  - ➤ One Client View (OneCV): Provide data to frontline officers with a comprehensive view of client information and assistance history

#### Other Tech Usage in Social Services

- Residential homes deploying technologies such as video analytics and sensor networks to enhance care.
  - "Predict behaviour" and monitor safety
- Human-like cleaning robots and an AI-enabled assistant with voice recognition
- Online Counselling on Family Assist (OCFA)
  - Allows individuals to seek professional counseling for marital, parenting, or divorce-related issues remotely
