## Excellency,

We are honoured to write to you in our capacity as Co-facilitators of the modalities and outcome of the intergovernmental preparatory process leading up to the "World Social Summit" in 2025, under the title "the Second World Summit for Social Development".

We are committed to facilitating the intergovernmental negotiation process in an open, inclusive, and transparent manner with a view to producing a concise and action-oriented political declaration to be adopted by consensus, and which should have a social development approach and give momentum towards the implementation of the 2030 Agenda. We are, equally, devoted to ensuring that all relevant stakeholders can participate and engage meaningfully in this process.

To this end we convened, as announced through your letter of October 21<sup>st</sup>, a first hearing for Member States on Monday, October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024, to hear expectations on the outcome of the Summit.

As promised to the delegations we are pleased to give the first indications of Roadmap of the negotiations of the Political Declaration of the "World Social Summit" in 2025, under the title "the Second World Summit for Social Development", so delegations have ample time to prepare for these negotiations. In this regard, we would like to announce the following:

- We aim to prepare a Food for Thought paper prior to the circulation of the Zero draft of the Political Declaration.
- We request Member States to send inputs for the Food for Thought paper <u>before February 7<sup>th</sup></u>, 2025.
- We request delegations to focus their inputs on the main substantive elements of the Political Declaration as well as its structure. Reflections on the timeline are of course welcome.
- We will then communicate the Food for Thought paper before the 21st of February 2025.
- We will hold an informal consultation on this Food for Thought Paper early March.
- The Zero Draft of the political declaration will be presented <u>before the end of March</u>.
- The Informal consultations on the Zero Draft <u>will start mid-April</u> with an intention to finalize the negotiations <u>early July</u>.
