States parties are kindly requested to forward the credentials issued by Head of State or Government, Minister of Foreign Affairs or other competent authorities as follows: (1) scanned copy of the credentials to be submitted through the online platform “e-Credentials” through the e-DELEGATE portal by 1 June 2022; and (2) original copy of the credentials to be submitted to the secretariat at the Conference prior to the opening of the 15<sup>th</sup> session on 14 June 2022.

Furthermore, States parties are kindly requested to notify the secretariat if their delegations have specific accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access, hearing loops usage, documentation in Braille, large print, or sign language usage via [enable@un.org](mailto:enable@un.org) no later than 15 May 2022, in order to ensure accessibility for all participants.
