#### Format of the Civil Society Forum

The Civil Society Forum will follow a format of a "People's Assembly" or a Townhall meeting. Following a brief opening, three substantive sessions will be held. The three sessions will be focused on specific pre-determined topics, namely mirroring the three COSP themes. The session will start off in a chat show style with the moderator very briefly laying out the outline of the topic. There will be no panel. Once the brief introduction is done, the moderator will invite organizations that have already been shortlisted through an open call for presentation to deliver a 3-minute statement, presentation or call to action on the topic in hand. Civil society organisations were invited to express interest in presenting during the CSF well in advance and short-listed applicants were informed. We will allocate 15 mins, per session, for any final interventions – these will be limited to one-minute reflections directly related to the discussion.
