FORUM ON INDIGENOUS ISSUES**

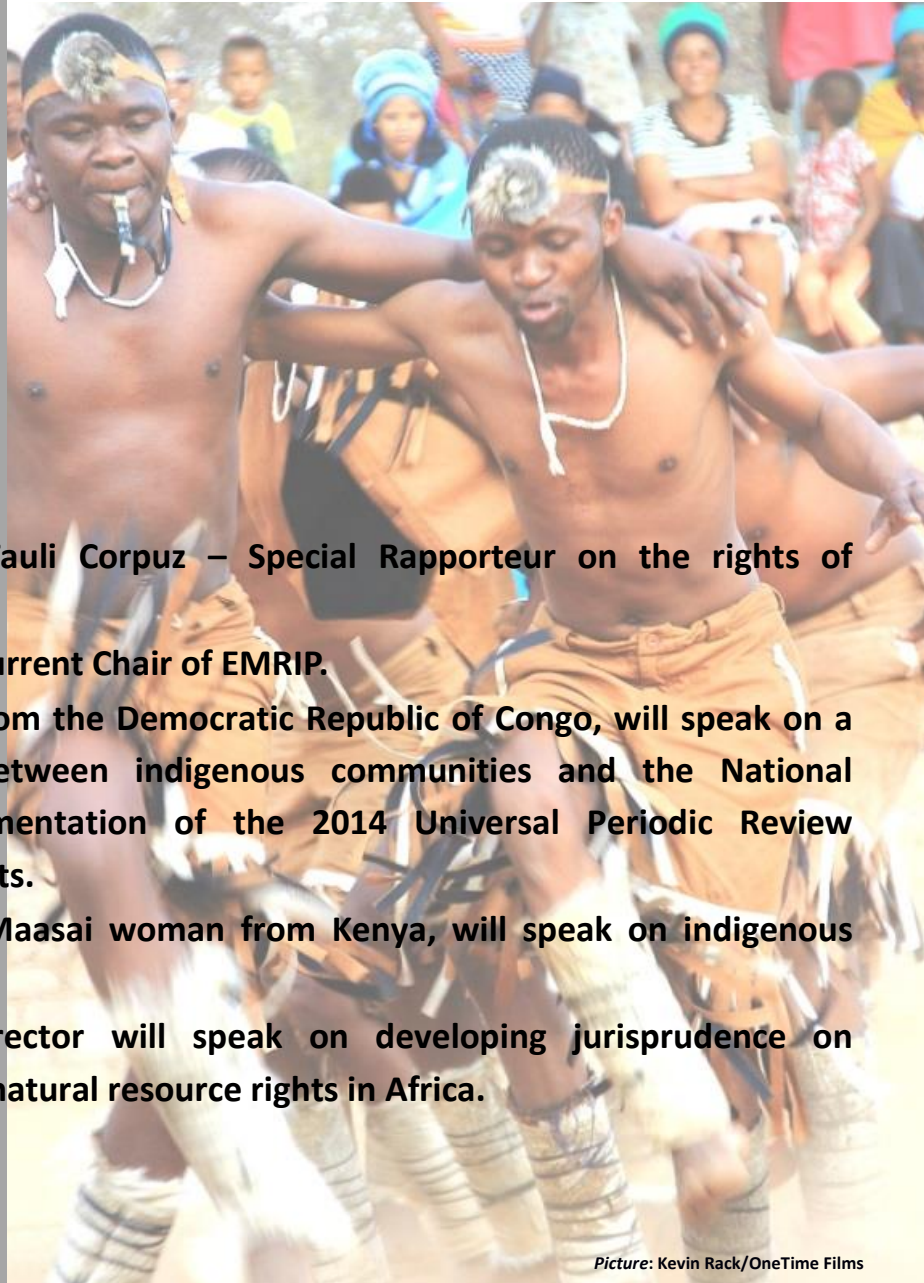
