Mr. Painter will present current research and policy work from the Royal Society of Arts (RSA) on economic security, including its links with Covid-19, automation, labour markets and a more comprehensive social contract.

Mr. Painter is Chief Research & Impact Officer (CRIO) at the RSA. He leads the Research and Impact team, overseeing research, policy and practical innovation. His own work focuses on a range of policy issues including the impact of new technology on the economy and society, reform to welfare, work, learning and skills, and reform to public services and a range of public institutions. He previously directed the Independent Review of the Police Federation and has also worked in partnership with Google, the BBC, the BMA, the Education and Training Foundation, the Association of Colleges and the Metropolitan Police. He is author of three books and regularly appears in national and international media.
