Objective

This parallel event will provide context, priorities and directions for the upcoming Decade of Healthy Ageing, as named by WHO. IAGG's regional representatives will draw attention to the inequalities and resulting disparities at the local, national, and regional levels faced by older adults. Speakers from the five international regions will reflect on best practices, lessons, and progress to " ... ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages" as outlined in the UN's 3rd SDG.
