



Mary A. Hums, PhD is a Professor of Sport Administration at the University of Louisville. In 2009, she was named a NASSM Earle F. Zeigler Lecturer, the organization's most prestigious academic honor. In 2006, the USOC selected her to represent the US at the International Olympic Academy in Olympia, Greece. She has worked 4 Paralympic Games, the Olympic Games, and the Para-Pan American Games, and is a former college Athletic Director. Hums co-authored Article 30.5 of the 2006 UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities. She has authored over 150 refereed journal articles and book chapters and given over 200 presentations in the United States and abroad. Her research interests are policy development in sport organizations regarding inclusion of people with disabilities and also sport and human rights.
