Age Nigeria Foundation is a Non-Governmental Organisation (Registration No CAC/IT/74674), Its solely dedicated to the elderly in our society by helping the aged and their family members to overcome challenges of aging, empowers the active elders

showing them the way to live with dignity in their in their silver years. We evolve a natural world where the aged will have unhindered access to good quality of life and flourish in our society where they will enjoy the optimum benefit of longer and dignified life. Nigeria is home to over 9 million elderly. The rapid urbanisation has affected the traditional value system of our people and eroded the safety net provided by their children who care for the elderly at old age. Son and daughters and their children have no time for the senior citizens in their family. The elderly, who have provided their services and support to the society, feel unloved and neglected at this pace of their lives. Their deteriorating physical strength and other geriatric illness add to their difficulties. Their terrible financial condition, lack of affordable healthcare and the general neglect by the society has propelled Yemi Age Nigeria Foundation to intervene and bring in elder welfare programme and advocate for elderly friendly policies for the past five years.

HOW WE SUPPORT THE SENIOR CITIZEN Age Nigeria Foundation has assisted over 10,000 plus old people and family members in Ogun State through our programme of community- based support by providing free medical services for the elderly to make them keep fit for life, our well being and health programme make them to have access to eye care, free screening for diabetes and hypertension, free drugs, free consultation with the doctors on various health issues and food stuffs and toiletries as gifts.

We passionately support the elderly living in both rural areas and urban areas to help them restrain from begging and improve their access to food and drugs.

Our visiting service to old people makes such a big difference to lonely older people to fight resilience and isolation.

BIG VOICE FOR THE OLD PEOPLE IN OUR SOCIETY-With over 30,000 registered older adult members in Nigeria we are creating a big voice for the old people to be appreciated and cared for in our society. The older people between the ages of 60 and above are fast becoming stakeholders in determining the future destiny of our state and the nation.

1 OCTOBER 2013 AJEROMI IFELODUN SOUTH WEST NIGERIA

Age Nigeria foundation organised human right workshop for older people in their 60s and we have over 200 older people present for the epoch making event in the urban slum

2 JANUARY 2014 BADAGRY LOCAL GOVERNMENT SOUTHWEST NIGERIA

Seminar on right of older people was organised and the event was used to create awareness of the problems of older people in Southwest Nigeria especially in Lagos. Over 50 people attended the event.

3 December 2014 .End of year party was held for older people in Okokomaiko a slum in Lagos Nigeria where there a lot of older people. The day was used to sensitise the elderly on their plight. we have over 100 older people present .

4 The Older people from Olodi part of Ajerom i Ifelodun have been living in an environment with little or no access to Medical Treatment. The Foundation came to their rescue with Free medical Programme to diagnose them if they complain of medical challenges and treat them .The Medical programme was also a means to reach out to the older people in Olodi and have face to face discussion with them. The event was very successful because they came out in large numbers which was an indication than for a long time they have not been reached and common issues concerning their old age experience were fully discussed. A church gave us the permission to use their premises. We delivered lecture on how to care for themselves and know their right in the society, and our team of medical personnel were on ground to treat the elderly over 1000 older people were present for treatment .Two medical Doctors were on ground led by Dr Oyewunmi from Tolu Medical Center led the team.

5 AN intergenerational programme was held for the elderly in Ijebu Ode where the youths and students of Anglican Girls Grammers School held a lecture and medical programme for the older people in Ijebu Ode and its environment. The whole communities was in a colourful mood because it was during the Founders day anniversary of the school. Older people who graced the occasion enjoyed the free medical programmes and they are over 1500. It was a memorable day because the students of the school were happy to host the older people who add colours to their founder day ceremony. Lectures were heard on health related issues with lots of fun and entertainment by the students and Management of the school including the olde students association and government officials were present to honour the older people. The event held in the school premises was an eye openers that older people are part of the communities and must be encouraged lots of gifts items were personally given to the older people by the presidents. It was an exciting period as flash mob was used and our volunteers really made the event a scintillating and memorable one. We appreciate the Student and staff of Anglican Girls Grammar School Ijebu Ode, The Old Student Association of Anglican Girls Grammar School. Our dedicated volunteers and Ambassadors.

These events are the highlights of our programmes in the SOUTHWEST NIGERIA in addition to our presence on Radio programme, facebook that we use to massively create awareness on Older peoples Right in our society. We look up to the coming year as a period that will herald activities and project with the testimonies and love for our programme for older people in Nigeria.

6 LAGOS NIGERIA

MAY 2015 The month of May will remain indelible in the history of older people in the rural town of Ilara Epe a town that is full of history and as ancient as few communities in Nigeria. The town played host to the biggest assembly of older people in the history of Nigeria, in the cause of finding solution to numerous problem confronting them. Age Nigeria Foundation has provided the platform for them to come together and form a common cause in an environment where government has no identified programme for them.

Age Nigeria Foundation organized Human Right of Older people Forum and Free Medical Treatment where over 3,000 older people were in attendant for the two day events.

We are mostly grateful for the Traditional ruler of Ilara His Royal Highness Oba Fatai Adesanya. Who is the Permanent Chairman Council of Obas in Epe Local government and he use is Leadership to ensure older people were mobilized to grace the occasion at his Expansive palace recently built. Alara kingdom as a town has several communities and older people came from far and near to the surprise of my team and the president of the organization who is also from the town. We learnt a lot from their leadership skill in the way they mobilized and encouraged lots of older people to grace their programme. I have never seen such a massive team. Our volunteers were supported by the youths from the town to ensure huge success of our programme. The older people enjoyed the topic of discussion and openly expressed their joy and support for the foundation with lots and lots of prayers. I was moved to tears to see how resourceful older people are yet we do not reckon with them. They were timely very orderly and show high level of maturity and wisdom. I gained a lot from them in spite of the fact that we refresh them with their rights

The medical team had full day immediately after the deliberations on the needs and healthcare challenges in the town. They were fully attended to by four medical doctors and eight nurses on ground. free drugs and food stuff were distributed to them which has always be the tradition of the president that older people has no right to sleep with empty stomach let alone use drugs without food.

The two day event really showed to us the need for government to be involved in older people activities in our nation. Their deplorable state and most of them living without care and in extreme poverty. This has lead to a lot of workshop from the team on how we can raise fund and improve on her care for older people in our nation. I am mostly grateful to the royal fathers present with their chiefs. I never seen group of royal fathers in my life overseeing their people as they attend our programme. It shows the level of love that existed by their traditional leaders to their subject.

JULY 2015 SOUTH SOUTH PORTHARCOURT NIGERIA

July witnessed our first programme for older people for the people of South- South .A workshop was held for older people in Portharcourt city in June. Human Right for the elderly and elderly empowerment was the topic of the one day event at Igboetse area of the town. Over 100 older people were in attendance. The older people who are suffering from social isolation and neglect expressed their deep feeling .We realize that such event should be a continuous events if fund could be available. We look forward to repeating the event in a bigger way next year.

OCTOBER 2015 SOUTHWEST NIGERIA
OGUN STATE REPORT JEREMIAH KESHIRO

Ogere Remo in Ogun held our major event of older people in Ogun State Southwest Nigeria. A gateway and border town where we have good mixture of all the major tribes in Nigeria was selected. In attendance were over 2,500 older people who deliberated on the Human Right Issues of older people and major topic like Madrid International plan of action on Ageing was fully discussed with lots of response and testimonies after the two day events. They equally benefited from our medical Medical Treatment which is always stretched to the limit due to lack of primary healthcare for older people in Nigeria.

NOVEMBER 2015 SOUTHWEST NIGERIA

The BIRTH OF CENTER FOR OLDER PEOPLE IN OGERE

Due to the impressive turn out and the problems they faced in the rural community which basically was loneliness. The foundation promised to establish a center for them to meet and discussed their issues from time to time. The promised was made well the following months where older people now meet to recreate and share their experiences and challenges of life. Games have been introduced to the center and we are working towards making Ogere town age friendly town with lot of community programmes and activities for the elderly. On weekly basis activities now comes alive at the center for the older people to be relevant in the society.

DECEMBER 2015 NORTH CENTRAL KWARA NORTH CENTRAL NIGERIA

Age Nigeria Foundation set up her retreat to discussed issues of older people and how the organization should be repositioned to tackle the ageing issue apathy in Nigeria. It was a great experience as the Organisation comes up with laudable strategies and programmes that will uplift the older people in Nigeria. Over time Age Nigeria has assisted over 50,000 older people in Nigeria and we have set an ambitious target to help one million older people in Nigeria in Nigeria tagged Project 2020. Yemi Age Nigeria Foundation made history by taking part with ADA GLOBAL ON HEALTH to mark world health day in Nigeria .We joined over 60 countries on World health day to mark this year event with special focus on diabetes .Over 10 ,000 older people benefited directly from our series of programme while over 100,000 benefitted indirectly.It was a major shift from our national activities.press review ,radio and TV presentation were part of the new initiatives with Help age International

JUNE 2016 HELPAGE INTERNATIONAL GLOBAL PROGRAMME

We were part of the Age Demands Action on the WEAD a global initiative to stop all forms of abuse against the elderly .More states were covered on our enlightenment campaign

OCTOBER HELPAGE INTERNATIONAL GLOBAL PROGRAMME

We were one of the two organisations that joined Help age International on global campaign on the right of older people and Take a Stand Against Ageism global initiative by WHO to condemn the prejudicial mistreatment and discrimination against the elderly in Nigeria.

- Our all inclusive ADA SUMMIT was a huge success in Lagos Nigeria and was followed by similar events in a Ogere a border town in Ogun State .AGEISM as the theme of this year ADA global on International day of older people was fully discussed, analysed with total practical action to stamp it out in our society by not only the older population but the younger population who are relevant in our drive to end ageism in Nigeria. The youth demonstrated this rigorously with their full participation and involvement in taking a stand against ageism.
- The new fusion of older peoples programmes with active participation of youths and children during ADA global was so unique as this brought out an idyllic and new experience not only for the youths but the older people who felt honoured. A particular reference was the case of young people in Ogere Ogun state Nigeria who aside from setting the sleeping town agog with Mini Marathon along their counterpart that came all the way from Moshood Abiola Polythecnic in Abeokuta and The Polytechnic Ibadan Oyo State.All the youth present embraced and hugged

older people during our event as a sign of renewed love and future commitment by youths to older people issues. The older people were touched by this action by the youth, they were elated because they expressed their feelings that being embraced by youths publicly in an event has never happened in the past where the youth openly display true love to the older people. An history was indeed made on International day of Older people

- The children consciousness about ageism was also another event where a special Mini Lecture for children was organised as part of ADA global in Nigeria with a theme SHOWING LOVE AND CARE FOR GRANDPARENTS, this was followed by fine art competition by selected pupils in Abeokuta Ogun State Capital City Nigeria. To encourage the children to love their grandparents and older people in their environment. The Mini Lecture was organised by youths, our ways to encourage them (youth)to be involved in older people programmes. Kudos to Olamilekan Adebola, Oluwadamilola Oluwole and group for the success of the Mini Lecture for children on Ageism.
- More politicians and government officials were encourage to join the campaign against ageism we were impressed with their turn up. Local government Officials representing the state government were present at the venue of our events in both Lagos and Ogun State.

We held a radio programme to sensitize the public on the negative effects of Ageism in our society. The radio station has majority of the audience who are youths was deliberately picked to reach out to the youths for them to know the adverse effect of ageism. UNILAG FM was a campus based FM Station. How to care for the Elderly and Issues on Ageism was discussed

- 1 Age Nigeria Foundation was on social media like Twitter, facebook and instagram, for over two months. We fully utilised the use Twitter handle for campaigns against ageism with lots of pictures and graphics from us Help- Age and other source. We did 8 -week countdown and make use of IDOP #tag. Facebook was also used, two events on facebook trend on ageism issues. The first was the older woman who contested for a local sit in the local council which would have given her the chance to represent older people in local parliament but the youth took to the facebook and attacks her personality. I personality seized the situation to campaign against ageism and see reason why youths must be involve in older people programmes. The second event was the translation of social media toolkit in to a local language by an expert in Yoruba language who has facebook page and this generate lots of interest by lovers of the local language on his wall who came up with lots of interpretation and comments on ageism.

The direct interpretation of social media toolkits in our local languages (Yoruba hausa and Igbo) will have more effect. The poster can be positioned in strategic environment and placed on billboards in cities for better awareness.

Help Age International resources helped to achieve the following

1. Please detail what was useful about these resources.

1 They helped to bring older people together to combat common enemy (ageism) that has deprived them right and discrimination in later life

2 They gave them the opportunity to share their experience and bring them out of their shell. Making them to have more hope for the future. Our Centres for older people now come more alive with these resources.

3 Conscious Raising Seminars have led to older people forming peer groups positively pushing for a common goal in Nigeria.

4 The impact of the resources and the emergent revelation on older people, this has encouraged us at Age Nigeria Foundation to introduce CRS to children btw age 7-16 yrs for them to create their world without ageism. By the year 2050 there will be more older people on the planet than children we need to catch them young. The result is overwhelming.

5 The resources has given birth to a new initiative to be implemented and spread across the country by Age Nigeria Foundation. HELP UNITE GREAT GENERATIONS IN NIGERIA (HUGGING). The initiative is to use youths to create awareness and help give voice to the rights of older people in Nigeria with series of events like drama, music by popular musicians and artists, television and radio programmes with the hope to commit the government to recognise the right of older people in all states in Nigeria. HUGGING is born out of impact of the resources provided by Help Age. The initiative will be launched in December. Conscious Raising Seminar, Role Playing, Testimonies Collections, Art Competition etc is about to give birth to HUGGING in Nigeria.

6 The resources were used to communicate the negative impact of Ageism in our Society.

7 It became an effective resources, for older people and youths to be in the same forum and diffuse social perceptions and prejudices within them, sharing their experiences and with a common resolve to end the menace which was demonstrated when the two group were engaged in long hug and embrace to show solidarity and love.

8 It brings about new orientation among the youth and children

Throughout the year we have organised series of awareness campaign and street rallies to create awareness about the human right issues in Nigeria with our network of organisation and Helpage International
