Running of Oldage Homes since 23 years (150 capacity), Destitute Rehabilitation Centre – 100 capacity (10 years) for Senior Citizens, Rural Hospital (24 years) and Cataract surgeries for senior citizens (24 years) – more than 950 surgeries per year, Health Services (24 years) – rural area for all class of people, Care for women – destitute and widowed, Elderly education – Research in Rural Ageing, Publication and news bulletin with the help of IFA eNews, Vocational training – computer & tailoring, Century Club for senior citizens above 80 years of age – 100 members, Networking of NGOs in Maharashtra, Rural Hub for Recreation, Yoga and Meditation Classes at various places mainly for senior citizens, Celebrating World Senior Citizens Day every year on 1st October and Meet the Stalwart wherein renowned senior persons from various fields are interviewed in order to motivate senior citizens specially who have taken premature retirement and physiotherapy centres for senior citizens

2. Represented International Federation on Ageing (IFA) by Dr. Vinod Shah as Director at Large and also member of Steering Committee of Planning Commission of India on Ageing and Participation in formulating State Policy for Senior Citizens for the State of Maharashtra

#### Programmes on Human Rights

1. We held Seminar on Human Rights (Elderly Abuse), Domestic Violence Act and 498A Act. A committee was formed of distinguished dignitaries headed by Dr. Sharadchandra Gokhale and formulated points for amendment in the act and submitted to Her Excellency Smt. Pratibhatai Patil, President of Republic of India, Central and State Law Ministers, Smt. Sonia Gandhi, Chairperson, National Advisory Council.

2. Arranged National Consultation on Active & Healthy Ageing in collaboration with WHO, ILC-I and IFA and formulated Pune Declaration and was submitted to Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India for incorporating in elderly policy.

3. Dr. Vinod Shah Addressed and gave presentation on Human Rights of Rural Elderly in seminar organized by University of Pune.

4. Janaseva is participating in the forthcoming 'XVIth National Conference' of Alzheimer and Related Disorders Society of India (ARDSI) along with Chaitanya Mental Institute, ILC-I and is represented by Dr. Vinod Shah as member, Scientific Committee, Mrs. Meena Shah, member of Joint Organizing Committee and Dr. Gururaj Mutalik as key note speaker.

5. Dr. Vinod Shah participated in teleconference on human rights organized by IFA.

Activities of Janaseva Foundation are carried out in and around Pune city, Pune Districts and nearby districts of state of Maharashtra.
